

SECURITY PROCEDURES / ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FOR USE OF A STU-III IN A RESIDENCE

(For use of this form see USARC Reg 380-6; the proponent agency is DCSINT)

The undersigned acknowledges, understands, and will comply with the following instructions governing the use of a STU-III in a residence.

- a. The STU-III will be strictly controlled while installed in my residence.
- b. The STU-III will be keyed only up to the **SECRET** level.
- c. Only authorized persons will be allowed access to a keyed STU-III.
- d. To prevent unauthorized use and/or loss, the STU-III cryptograph ignition key (CIK) will be removed when not in use. The CIK will be in my personal possession or stored in a locked cabinet or drawer in an area separate from the STU-III.
- e. I will not use the STU-III to discuss classified information when uncleared personnel are present.
- f. The room in which the STU-III is installed will have a lockable door which will be closed and locked during classified discussions.
- g. ***I will not take notes while conducting a classified discussion.***
- h. I will report any usual incidents involving my residence, loss of the CIK or loss of the STU-III to the Senior Intelligence Officer (SIO).
- i. I will ensure that **BOTH** the STU-III and CIK are returned to the Property Book Officer (PBO) when no longer required, before I move from this residence, or if the residence will be unoccupied for a period of two weeks, or longer. I will notify the USARC DCSINT, ATTN: AFRC-INS when the STU-III is returned.
